DISCUSSION NOTES	There is a camera at the front office for the office staff to see who is ringing the doorbell to come in and then approve their entry, but it is a camera that is small and hard to see. A new camera would be better for staff to easily recognize people attempting to come into the building. Another safety measure thing our school would benefit from is a keypad lock on the work room door which gives access to the playing fields. There is a bond up for election in November that would cover the cost of these safety measures, but we'd like to have a plan in case the bond is not approved by Tucson voters.
