It did put us over our \$300 limit. The total spent was \$329.28. PTA officials decided to amend the spending limit to \$330. Treasurer: PTA Taxes Update ☐ The PTA submits taxes in November each year. This year, our taxes were rejected by the IRS because of the 2-3 consecutive years of our taxes not being submitted correctly. ☐ For now, we submitted paperwork for a new EIN number to use for tax donation receipts. New Business (Vice President):

- Noche De Gala Decorations Amendment (Ms. Swift)
 - O Black paint spray cans 5.16 + white paint spray cans 7.74 + 5-gallon bucket 7.96 + 2-gallon bucket 11.92 = \$35.63 + 8.69 lights
 - New Total: \$50 + \$55.08 (already spent)
 - o Increase decoration budget to \$150 (total estimated to be spent)
- Noche De Gala Food Amendment
 - \circ We still need to purchase Pan Dulce (2 extra boxes) \$30, water to make the hot cocoa \$1 per gallon x 9 = \$12, water bottles to sell (3 cases for \$5.99 each = \$22), hot coffee cups
 - New total: \$ 80 (estimated to be spent) + \$61.50 (already spent)
 - Increase food budget to \$175 (total expected to be spent)

 - Decorations Proposed Budget \$50
